CLEVER Cities is bringing UrbanByNature (UbN), the global program for urban nature pioneers, to Latin America. After a successful launch event on 19 and 20 April in Quito, UbN will kick-start a five-part webinar series for Latin America on 02 June. Throughout the program, participants will be introduced to nature-based solutions (NBS) and how they are being implemented across cities in Latin America.

The first webinar will focus on STEP2 of the UbN methodology, which is about EXPLORING the local framework conditions for implementing nature-based solutions and creating greener, more sustainable and resilient environments. In particular, city practitioners from Germany, Argentina and Mexico will introduce different pathways and methods to collaborate with local communities. Co-creation is a key aspect of CLEVER Cities project, as it helps to understand local needs and identify challenges and opportunities for advancing NBS.
