

Exploring the Process - Step 8: Develop a communication, education and public awareness strategy

Communication is key to securing support for urban nature plans. Step 8 focuses on raising awareness of the importance of urban nature and the benefits it brings to cities. This includes behaviour change campaigns, education programmes and public information strategies to engage citizens and stakeholders. It also fulfils milestone 5: Communication strategy to ensure that the UNP is widely understood and supported.

Key actions:

- ✓ Develop a strategy to inform the public about the benefits of urban nature.
- ✓ Launch campaigns to raise awareness and encourage behaviour change.
- ✔ Allocate resources to ensure effective implementation of communication activities.
